VI. New Business

a. Parli Topics - (*Wyman/Decarbo*) **MSP**

Strike "will be singular in nature and"; so it will now read:

Parliamentary Debate topics will alternate between metaphor, policy, and value resolutions.

Add back in subsections F through H.

F. Three topics will be provided for each round. The government team strikes one topic, then

the opposition team strikes one topic. The remaining topic is debated.

G. In elimination rounds, one of each type of topic will be provided (metaphor, current event, and philosophical). The government team strikes one topic, then the opposition team strikes one topic. The remaining topic is debated.

H. Once the topic has been received, no person may be consulted except the partner or the Speaker of the House.

b. Parli Topics - (*Cantrell/Crossman*) **MSP**

Topics shall be constructed by a topic committee consisting of a variety of coaches from Southern and Northern California. The Committee will be appointed by the tournament director.

c. NFA L-D - (*Cantrell/Glines*) **MSP**

NFA LD would run in Pattern A and will be run consistent with the National Forensics Association rules and guidelines. All judges will sign a judging certification form affirming they will apply the NFA-LD rules (eg. Argument types, Style, etc...). Schools will be limited to no more than four (4) LD slots total (Incl. Parli, Policy, and NFA).

(rules will be taken from NFA Bylaws and place in CCCFA ByLaws)

d. Judging Requirements (*Koepfel/Nite*)

- 1 Team = 3 round commitment, 2 Teams = 6 round commitment
- 1 LD = 3 round commitment, 2 LDs = 6 round commitment

- 1 IT = 6 round commitment, 1 judge covers 4 individual event slots (or fraction thereof) per pattern.

- k. **Make Double Entry Rule Permanent MSP** (*Koeppel/DeSurra*)
Remove the (For a one year trial period) from the provision that allows for double entry in the Combined pattern (Almost always C/D). Still limited to no more than two per school.
